

# SEEDS OF ART CHARITY FOUNDATION COMPANY LIMITED ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND EXPLANATORY NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31<sup>ST</sup> MARCH, 2014

### 1. GENERAL INFORMATION

Seeds of Art Charity Foundation Company Limited (the association) is a company incorporated and domiciled in Hong Kong with liability limited by guarantee. The registered office is situated at Unit 406, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Citylink Plaza, Shatin, New Territories, Hong Kong. The principal activities of the association are to provide assistance to students in rural mountain areas in the Mainland China.

The financial statements are presented in Hong Kong Dollars which is the same as the functional currency of the association.

### 2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

a. Statement of compliance

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standard for Private Entities (HKFRS for Private Entities) issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants (HKICPA). These financial statements also comply with the applicable requirements of the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance which concern the preparation of financial statements, which for this financial year and the comparative period continue to be those of the predecessor Hong Kong Companies Ordinance, Cap. 32, in accordance with transitional and saving arrangements for Part 9 of the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance, Cap. 622, "Account and Audit", which are set out in sections 76 to 87 of Schedule 11 to that Ordinance. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention. A summary of the significant accounting policies adopted by the Association is set out below.

b. Basis of preparation of the financial statements The financial statements have been prepared under the accrual basis of accounting and on the basis that the association is on a going concern. The measurement basis used in the preparation of these financial statements is historical cost.

### 2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONTINUED)

Revenue recognition
 Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable.

Revenue is recognised when it is probable that the economic benefits will flow to the association and when the revenue can be measured reliably, on the following bases:

- (i) Donation receipt is recognised in the financial period of receipt.
- (ii) Membership fee received is recognised in the financial period of receipt.
- (iii) Interest income is recognised on time proportion basis, taking into account the principal outstanding and the effective interest rates applicable.
- d. Cash and cash equivalents
  For statement of cash flows purpose, cash and cash equivalents comprises cash at
  bank and on hand, demand deposits with banks and other financial institutions, and
  short-term, highly liquid investments that are readily convertible into known amounts
  of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of change in value, having been
  within three months of maturity at acquisition.
- e. Translation of foreign currencies Monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies at the end of the year are translated into Hong Kong dollars at approximately the market rates of exchange ruling at the reporting date. Foreign currency transactions occurred during the year is translated into Hong Kong dollars at the actual exchange rates applicable at the transaction dates. Gain or loss arising from this translation policy is dealt with in profit or loss.
- f. Related parties
  For the purpose of these financial statements, related party includes a person and entity as defined below:
  - (a) A person or a close member of that person's family is related to the association if that person:
    - (i) is a member of the key management personnel of the association;
    - (ii) has control over the association; or

- (iii) has joint control or significant influence over the reporting entity or has significant voting power in it.
- (b) An entity is related to the association if any of the following conditions applies:
  - (i) the entity and the association are members of the same group.
  - (ii) either entity is an associate or joint venture of the other entity.
  - (iii) both entities are joint ventures of a third entity.

### 2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONTINUED)

f. Related parties (continued)

- (iv) either entity is a joint venture of a third entity and the other entity is an associate of the third entity.
- the entity is a post-employment benefit plan for the benefit of employees of either the association or an entity related to the association. If the reporting entity is itself such a plan, the sponsoring employers are also related to the
- (vi) the entity is controlled or jointly controlled by a person identified in (a).
- (vii) a person identified in (a)(i) has significant voting power in the entity.
- g. Taxation

The association has been exempted from tax under section 88 of the Inland Revenue Ordinance and accordingly, no tax was paid nor provided during the year.
